The biggest is our in-progress <u>Modular Production Kitchens</u>. We have two trailers that are already being converted into these MPKs, and once completed, they will allow us to store, prepare and share more food than we ever have before.

From cooking classes to food delivery partnerships to extended "food tours" with our food truck and more, these MPKs offer a **major step forward** in our fight against food insecurity in our community.
